The Club President

The Club President leads the Club, motivates and involves its members, encourages the development of the membership and ensures the promotion of Rotary and the funding of the Foundation.

He/she is elected by the General Assembly of the Club between 18 and 24 months before taking office. He/she is then President-nominee.

He/she becomes President-elect 12 months before taking office.

He/she oversees the organization of friendly and attractive statutory meetings.

He/she animates the monthly meetings of the Committee and the Assemblies of the club.

He/she sets annual objectives, registers them on the RI website and supervises the preparation of the budget and the management of finances.

He/she ensures that the Secretary and Treasurer have an account on www.rotary.org and monitors the club's progress in Rotary Club Central.

He/she prepares the official visit of the Governor.

He/she encourages members to attend District meetings and he promotes the Rotary Convention.
